IS YOUR BIKE SECURED?

The first line of defense against bike thieves is a good bike lock! See our bike lock recommendations below - including some recommended by New York Times.

The [ABUS U-Lock](#) is our recommended lock.

This [heavy duty bike lock](#) is a good cheaper alternative.

This [NOEAIKE lock](#) is another good alternative.

Recommended by [New York Times](#), the [Kryptonite Evolution](#) was their top pick out of 35 bike locks they tested.

The most important thing to keep in mind is that there is no perfect solution to stop a determined thief. Do your research and stay vigilant!
