BICYCLE SAFETY TIPS

- 1 PROTECT YOUR HEAD**

Ensure your helmet fits snugly and is positioned correctly, covering your forehead, with straps forming a 'V' shape under the ears. Also, regularly ensure your tires are inflated, brakes work, and the chain is maintained. Consider wearing eye protection.
- 2 FOLLOW TRAFFIC RULES**

Stop at all stop signs and red lights, and follow the same rules as motorists. Ride with the flow of traffic, not against it. Always signal your turns to drivers and pedestrians using hand signals.
- 3 SEE AND BE SEEN**

Do not assume drivers see you. Do not use headphones in both ears or mobile devices while riding. Ride predictably, ride in a straight line, avoiding weaving in and out of traffic. Wear neon or fluorescent clothing, and use front and rear lights when riding at dawn, dusk, or night.
- 4 WATCH FOR ROAD HAZARDS**

Watch for potholes, debris, grates, and car doors opening. Look over your shoulder to check for traffic before turning or changing lanes. Plan your route to account for construction and busy or heavy traffic areas.
